



- This year, we celebrate the 27th edition of the Bahrain Annual Heritage Festival, a tradition that is organized by the Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities every April since 1992.
- The theme of this year's festival is "Arabian Horses".
- The festival welcomes its visitors at the Riffa Fort from April 24 until May 3, daily from 5:00 9:00 PM



Over the course of many millennia, the Arabian Peninsula nurtured a special bond between horses, the desert and Arabs. This bond was not merely that of a rider and his steed, but one of love, friendship and loyalty. Horses were – and remain – a symbol of wealth and status, with Arab poetry devoting entire works to describing their various desirable and much admired traits.



#### HUNTING

Long ago, Arabs used horses for hunting. They excelled in hunting in wild animals while on horseback. One of the pre-Islamic poets, Imru' Al-Qais, described such hunting excursions in his poetry. Ancient Assyrian and Egyptian drawings depict horse riders hunting lions and bulls.

Arabian horses are renowned for their incredible endurance and tolerance of thirst, hunger and extreme heat, as well as their tremendous speed when galloping.



In the past, Arabian horses wore very basic equipment when they were used in warfare. In times of peace, however, to mark happy occasions such as weddings, national celebrations and official occasions, horses were dressed in the most stunning equipment of that time, such as brightly-colored saddles, and were ridden by horse riders in their dazzling full ceremonial regalia and armed with rifles, swords and daggers. Horse equipment today is very different than what they were, as the rudimentary equipment evolved into more modern and lightweight assortment of equipment. There are three main pieces of equipment for horses today, and they are: bridles, saddles and horseshoes.

- In the past, horses were only used in warfare.
- Horses do not wear equipment in battle.
- Horse riders can wear their full ceremonial regalia armed with rifles, swords and daggers.
- Horses today wear three main pieces of equipment: bridles, saddles and horseshoes.




## 1. Bridle

This is put on the horse's head to prevent it from opening its mouth too wide

#### 2. Saddle

This is the seat that is placed on the horse's back for the horse rider to sit on








#### 3. Horseshoe

This piece of equipment protects the hoof from rough surfaces, as well keeping the horse from stumbling and falling and getting seriously injured.






